


Supply Chain Compliance Snapshot

In addition to all the usual terms of supply (ordering, payment, delivery, risk, title, IP etc.....) it is essential that you ensure your supply contracts are drafted with the following key issues in mind to ensure compliance with current legislation and regulations:



In each case:

As a **purchaser** can you be confident that your supplier is acting within the boundaries of current laws? What contractual reassurances do you have and what remedies are available to you in the case of a breach.

As a **supplier** are you confident that you are compliant? Are your subcontractors compliant and do you have back-to-back warranties/indemnities from them?

Whether a purchaser or supplier you should ensure internal policies, procedures and training are in place in relation to each of these compliance topics.
